AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to enacting the agreement among the states to elect the president by national popular vote

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 12 of the election law is amended by adding a new 1 2 title 4 to read as follows: 3

TITLE IV

AGREEMENT AMONG THE STATES TO ELECT THE

PRESIDENT BY NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE

SECTION 12-400. SHORT TITLE.

12-402. ADOPTION AND TEXT OF COMPACT. 7 12-400. SHORT TITLE. THIS TITLE SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS 8 "AGREEMENT AMONG THE STATES TO ELECT THE PRESIDENT BY NATIONAL 9 POPULAR 10 VOTE'

S 12-402. ADOPTION AND TEXT OF COMPACT. THE AGREEMENT AMONG THE STATES 11 TO ELECT THE PRESIDENT BY NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE IS ADOPTED AND ENACTED 12 13 INTO LAW AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

MEMBERSHIP. ANY STATE OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUM-15 16 BIA MAY BECOME A MEMBER OF THIS AGREEMENT BY ENACTING THIS AGREEMENT.

ARTICLE II

18 RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE IN MEMBER STATES TO VOTE FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE 19 PRESIDENT. EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL CONDUCT A STATEWIDE POPULAR ELECTION 20 FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

ARTICLE III

MANNER OF APPOINTING PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS IN MEMBER STATES. 1. PRIOR 22 23 TO THE TIME SET BY LAW FOR THE MEETING AND VOTING BY THE PRESIDENTIAL 24 ELECTORS, THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFICIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL DETER-25 MINE THE NUMBER OF VOTES FOR EACH PRESIDENTIAL SLATE IN EACH STATE OF

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets { } is old law to be omitted.

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THE UNITED STATES AND IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA IN WHICH VOTES HAVE 1 BEEN CAST IN A STATEWIDE POPULAR ELECTION AND SHALL ADD SUCH VOTES TOGETHER TO PRODUCE A "NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE TOTAL" FOR EACH PRESIDEN-2 3 4 TIAL STATE.

5 THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFICIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL DESIGNATE 2. 6 THE PRESIDENTIAL SLATE WITH THE LARGEST NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE TOTAL AS THE "NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE WINNER" 7

3. THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CERTIFYING OFFICIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE 8 9 SHALL CERTIFY THE APPOINTMENT IN THAT OFFICIAL'S OWN STATE OF THE ELEC-10 TOR SLATE NOMINATED IN THAT STATE IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE NATIONAL POPU-11 LAR VOTE WINNER.

LEAST SIX DAYS BEFORE THE DAY FIXED BY LAW FOR THE MEETING AND 12 4. AT VOTING BY THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS, EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL MAKE A FINAL DETERMINATION OF THE NUMBER OF POPULAR VOTES CAST IN THE STATE OF 13 14 EACH PRESIDENTIAL SLATE AND SHALL COMMUNICATE AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT OF 15 16 SUCH DETERMINATION WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS TO THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFI-CIAL OF EACH OTHER MEMBER STATE. 17

18 5. THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFICIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL TREAT AS 19 CONCLUSIVE AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT CONTAINING THE NUMBER OF POPULAR VOTES IN A STATE FOR EACH PRESIDENTIAL SLATE MADE BY THE DAY ESTABLISHED BY FEDERAL LAW FOR MAKING A STATE`S FINAL DETERMINATION CONCLUSIVE AS TO 20 21 22 THE COUNTING OF ELECTORAL VOTES BY CONGRESS.

6. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE FOR THE NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE WINNER, THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CERTIFYING OFFICIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL CERTIFY THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ELECTOR SLATE NOMINATED IN ASSOCIATION 23 24 25 WITH THE PRESIDENTIAL SLATE RECEIVING THE LARGEST NUMBER OF POPULAR VOTES WITHIN THAT OFFICIAL`S OWN STATE. IF, FOR ANY REASON, THE NUMBER OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS NOMINATED IN A MEMBER STATE IN ASSOCIATION WITH 26 27 28 THE NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE WINNER IS LESS THAN OR GREATER THAN THAT 29 STATE`S NUMBER OF ELECTORAL VOTES, THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE ON 30 THE PRESIDENTIAL SLATE THAT HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS THE NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE WINNER SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO NOMINATE THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS FOR 31 32 THAT STATE AND THAT STATE S PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CERTIFYING OFFICIAL 33 SHALL CERTIFY THE APPOINTMENT OF SUCH NOMINEES. THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFI-34 CIAL OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL IMMEDIATELY RELEASE TO THE PUBLIC ALL 35 VOTE COUNTS OR STATEMENTS OF VOTES AS THEY ARE DETERMINED OR OBTAINED. 36 7. THIS ARTICLE SHALL GOVERN THE APPOINTMENT OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS IN EACH MEMBER STATE IN ANY YEAR IN WHICH THIS AGREEMENT IS, ON JULY 37 38 TWENTIETH, IN EFFECT IN STATES CUMULATIVELY POSSESSING A MAJORITY OF THE 39 ELECTORAL VOTES. 40

ARTICLE IV

OTHER PROVISIONS. THIS AGREEMENT SHALL TAKE EFFECT WHEN STATES CUMULA-42 TIVELY POSSESSING A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORAL VOTES HAVE ENACTED THIS AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME FORM AND THE ENACTMENTS BY SUCH 43 44 STATES HAVE TAKEN EFFECT IN EACH STATE. ANY MEMBER STATE MAY WITHDRAW 45 FROM THIS AGREEMENT, EXCEPT THAT A WITHDRAWAL OCCURRING SIX MONTHS OR LESS BEFORE THE END OF A PRESIDENT`S TERM SHALL NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL A PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT SHALL HAVE BEEN QUALIFIED TO SERVE 46 47 48 THE NEXT TERM. THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF EACH MEMBER STATE SHALL PROMPTLY 49 NOTIFY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF ALL OTHER STATES OF WHEN THIS AGREEMENT 50 HAS BEEN ENACTED AND HAS TAKEN EFFECT IN THAT OFFICIAL'S STATE, WHEN THE 51 STATE HAS WITHDRAWN FROM THIS AGREEMENT, AND WHEN THIS AGREEMENT TAKES 52 53 EFFECT GENERALLY.

54 THIS AGREEMENT SHALL TERMINATE IF THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE IS ABOLISHED.

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1 IF ANY PROVISION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD INVALID, THE REMAINING 2 PROVISIONS SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED.

ARTICLE V DEFINITIONS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS AGREEMENT:

4 1. "CHIEF EXECUTIVE" SHALL MEAN THE GOVERNOR OF A STATE OF THE UNITED STATES OR THE MAYOR OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. 2. "ELECTOR SLATE" SHALL MEAN A SLATE OF CANDIDATES WHO HAVE BEEN 5 6

NOMINATED IN A STATE FOR THE POSITION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR IN ASSOCI-8 ATION WITH A PRESIDENTIAL SLATE. 3. "CHIEF ELECTION OFFICIAL" SHALL MEAN THE STATE OFFICIAL OR BODY 9

10 THAT IS AUTHORIZED TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POPULAR VOTES FOR EACH 11 12 PRESIDENTIAL SLATE.

4. "PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR" SHALL MEAN AN ELECTOR FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE 13 PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES. 14

"PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR CERTIFYING OFFICIAL" SHALL MEAN THE STATE 15 5. 16 OFFICIAL OR BODY THAT IS AUTHORIZED TO CERTIFY THE APPOINTMENT OF THE STATE`S PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS. 17

"PRESIDENTIAL SLATE" SHALL MEAN A SLATE OF TWO PERSONS, THE FIRST 18 6. OF WHOM HAS BEEN NOMINATED AS A CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE SECOND OF WHOM HAS BEEN NOMINATED AS A CANDIDATE FOR VICE 19 20 21 PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, OR ANY LEGAL SUCCESSORS TO SUCH PERSONS, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER BOTH NAMÉS APPEAR ON THE BALLOT PRESENTED TO THE 22 VOTER IN A PARTICULAR STATE. 7. "STATE" SHALL MEAN A STATE OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF 23

24 25 COLUMBIA.

"STATEWIDE POPULAR ELECTION" SHALL MEAN A GENERAL ELECTION IN WHICH 26 8. VOTES ARE CAST FOR PRESIDENTIAL SLATES BY INDIVIDUAL VOTERS AND COUNTED 27 28 ON A STATEWIDE BASIS.

S 2. The commissioner of the board of elections shall notify the legislative bill drafting commission upon the occurrence of the adoption 29 30 31 of the agreement among the states to elect the president by national

popular vote by two or more states in order that the commission may maintain an accurate and timely effective data base of the official text of the laws of the state of New York in furtherance of effecting the provisions of section 44 of the legislative law and section 70-b of the public officers law.
